



HUDL FILM EXCHANGE

Teams will be using HUDL to upload their most recent film **that does not include an opponent in the championship field (either opening round or final site)**. The system is easy to use and HUDL's support team is ready to help you throughout the process. As always, it is imperative that the game required to be uploaded needs to be recorded for use in the National Championship Film Exchange.

Below is an overview of the requirements and instructions on how the Film Exchange process will work –

1. Per NAIA rules, you are required to upload and share your most recent game played to the Tournament Film Exchange by **Wednesday, November 15th – by 12:00 Noon (CT)**.
2. The NAIA and HUDL will be monitoring uploads to ensure all teams meet the required deadline.
3. You will not receive viewing access to the National Championship Film Exchange until your most recent game film is uploaded.

ACCESSING YOUR HUDL ACCOUNT AND UPLOADING MOST RECENT GAME FILM

All qualifying teams will have a HUDL account created and be added to the NAIA Women's Volleyball Championship Film Exchange on **Monday, November 13th**, following the bracket announcement.

- Current HUDL users will login as usual.
- Non-HUDL users will have a team account created under the head coach's school email address. Upon creation of the account, a welcome email will be sent to that email address. You will need to click the link in that email to access your account.

To complete the process of uploading video and simultaneously adding to the NAIA Championship Exchange, please see the attached HUDL Handout that has visual aids.

HUDL will be giving each team participating in the Championship Week, seven (7) [HUDL Assist](#) credits during the National Tournament. Teams can find any video in the exchange and submit as they so choose. If a team utilizes all credits, a coach on staff can reach out to the HUDL representative on site to receive extra credits at no charge.

1. Once the Assist breakdown on each game is complete, you will see "Data" available once you select a game from the Exchange schedule. Use the steps above to add the video with the full breakdown data to your video library.
2. If you've already added the raw video (without breakdown data) to your library from the Exchange, **redo the steps above to add the video with breakdown data to your library**. It will appear as a second video with a "tag" icon on the video in your library. From there you can use the "Reports" tab to view reports, or filter through the stats while watching the video.

USING YOUR HUDL ACCOUNT DURING FINAL SITE

A HUDL rep will be on-site at the National Championship Final Site in Sioux City and can walk you through these steps at any time and provide additional on-site support. On-site contacts will provide email addresses and cell phone numbers at the beginning of Championship week.
