National Office Update – Brad Cygan - The NAIA is working on ways to help promote their NAIA Tournament selection shows. They ran well and were very well received by the membership. If the NAIA could get have more time from the time it receives the teams qualifying for NAIA post season compared to when they have to release the information, they would be able to have more in depth video selection shows. NAIA is working with Rick of Referee Photo to post photos in a quicker manner of NAIA National Championship events.

Sponsorship Committee – Tyler Price - The sponsorship committee and the NAIA has agreed to a 60/40 split of revenue from sponsorships. So 60-percent of the funds from a sponsor will go to the NAIA and 40-percent will go to NAIA-SIDA.

Some ideas of where those funds will go: *NAIA-SIDA Grant to help a young SID travel to CoSIDA Convention for the first time, have a percentage go to the CoSIDA Academic All-America program, Donate a percentage to a Charity, pay for the Play for Pat award, help the Ike Pearson award winner bring more of their friends and family to see them accept the Ike Pearson award, have a portion go towards the Ike Pearson award reception to enhance the event.*

Treasurer Report – Wendy Reid - We have about \$3,500 in our NAIA-SIDA budget at the moment.

Aaron Sagraves –We have about 100 NAIA-SIDA paid members.

Brad Cygan – NAIA-SIDA will receive about \$47 per NAIA-SIDA paid membership out of the \$50 fee.
